WHAT ARE NDAD COMMUNITY FUNDRAISERS?

They are conducted by friends and families of one or more people with a disability or health challenge. NDAD acts as custodian of all funds raised. These funds can be used to help with the client's urgent needs and expenses.

The funds also may be used beyond the scope of NDAD's guidelines, such as helping with doctor, clinic or hospital bills and paying pre-existing bills.

NDAD allows use of the client's bank of choice to hold the funds raised.

NDAD offers the service free of charge. All funds raised will be spent on the client's needs.

NDAD has sponsored numerous community fundraisers throughout the state. If desired, NDAD will provide references from individuals who have used NDAD for this purpose.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF HOLDING A COMMUNITY FUNDRAISER THROUGH NDAD?

- NDAD is a 501(c)3 charitable nonprofit organization. Any funds donated to NDAD qualify as a charitable donation and are deductible for donors who itemize. Funds donated to non-501(c)3 bank accounts are not deductible.
- Donations directly to an individual may cause that person to lose eligibility for various public assistance programs. Using NDAD as the fund custodian should protect that eligibility.
- NDAD is an established, reputable organization, which makes individuals more likely to donate.
- NDAD provides marketing and consulting expertise to help community volunteers with fundraising ideas. NDAD personnel will create and/or copy posters, letters and other advertising items necessary for fundraisers, plus provide active social media assistance, including a means of donating online on NDAD's website, NDAD.org.
- NDAD tracks the funds raised and expenses paid. The client, family member or representative can bring in a donation and NDAD will provide the necessary accounting functions.
- Approved bills must be submitted to NDAD and will be paid with donated funds. This can be a great relief to individuals dealing with overwhelming situations. It also is convenient for clients if they are at medical facilities out of town for long periods of time.
