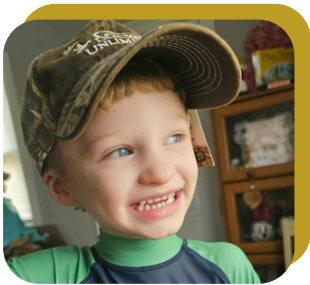

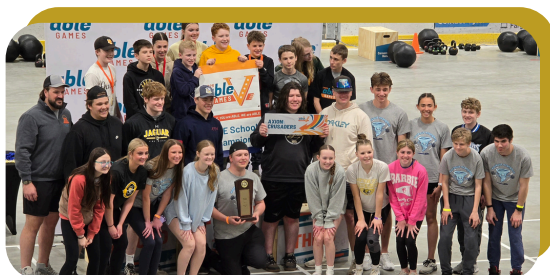

2025 at a Glance

- Loaned **6,005 pieces of medical equipment** to **3,141 individuals** saving North Dakota residents **over \$576,634**
- **4,380 prescriptions** filled
- **2,093 medical trips** funded and **95 hotel rooms** provided for trips.
- Purchased **470 pieces of medical equipment** and **531 medical supplies**
- **Wheelchair-accessible van** loaned to **148 individuals** for **325 trips**.
- Funds totaling **\$950,742 awarded to 29 organizations** to either assist individuals with disabilities or those otherwise at risk
 - Including **\$800,000 to Grand Forks Park District** for the development of NDAD Park Inclusive Playground
- **9,885 accessible rides** funded for employment, shopping, and community events
- **5,164 hours** of personal attendant care, respite care provided
- **66,365 interactions made**, such as phone calls, emails and other communication
